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- 1- When you are grace oriented, it becomes very easy to identify evil. Remember, evil is anything that is in total opposition to grace.
- 2- Evil therefore may involve sin but not necessarily. It may also include human good or a combination of sin and human good.
- 3- For example, homosexuality is a sin. It is no better or worse than any other sin. However when the idea is developed that homosexual activity is not sinful but simply an alternate lifestyle then you have the intrusion of human good.
- 4- When legal actions follow which classify homosexuality as a legitimate lifestyle choice equal to and as virtuous as heterosexual marriage then you have evil.
- 5- When this evil is promoted and accepted as a part of the culture, i.e., taught as normal behavior in school sex ed, presented as normal activity in literature and drama, or regarded as inconsequential in the hiring of teachers, youth workers or counselors, then homosexuality has become a part of the national Zeitgeist. (Sun. 14 Oer, 1990 A&B GEN 11-19)
- 6- On a number of occasions we have defined the three major areas of what the Bible classifies as ADIKI'A, translated into the English with such words as "iniquity," "unrighteousness," and "wickedness."
- 7- The word ADIKI'A literally means "no integrity," and refers to the actions of men in the three categories of sin, human good and evil.
 - 8- Such lack of integrity is manifest in three areas of wrongdoing: Cosmic One arrogance, Cosmic Two hatred and the 8 stages of Reversionism.
 - 9- When an individual or a people habitually function in these areas then they have gone beyond the normal commission of personal sin, human good and evil.
- 10- It has now become a mind-set, a lifestyle, a way of life. This is the thinking--or lack of it--which identifies those who reject truth and believe the lie.
- 11- Zeitgeist is an English term adopted from the German which refers to the prevailing intellectual, cultural and moral climate of an era. It literally means, "the spirit of the time."

- 12- Consequently it becomes obvious that our national Zeitgeist has been steadily transforming itself for the past half century under the influence of a worldview which does not stress absolutes.
- 13- At odds is a worldview which claims no society can survive which does not govern itself by absolute standards while the other worldview insists that all standards are debatable and final choices should be left to the individual based on what is best for him.
 - 1- Truth: The only legitimate area for the practice of physical sex is the heterosexual union of right man right woman within the boundaries of marriage.

Lie: Alternate lifestyles are acceptable equivalents of the traditional institution of marriage. One is just as moral as the other and to think otherwise is not being "up with the times." Of course this is a part of the Zeitgeist of any nation involved in national reversionism.

2- Truth: All organizational structures should emphasize male authority over female authority.

Lie: Feminism which emphasizes the authority of the female over the male and the imposition of this standard by law. Government by women is called a gynecocracy.

3- Truth: The only source of information for establishing right and wrong regarding human relationships is the <u>Bible</u>.

Lie: All Biblical principles must be legally censored in order to preserve the wall of separation between church and state. Truth will be determined by the individual based on what is best for him at the moment.

4- Truth: The only way the sinful nature of fallen mankind can in any way be restrained is through the development of laws, supported by a common culture within a national entity. Governmental authority must establish an environment which protects the freedom, privacy, property and life of each of its citizens. The absolute principles which must be recognized in order to provide that environment are the final six commandments in addition to many other establishment principles found in Scripture.

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
