v 20 = Nevertheless, if your enemy is hungry, feed him. If he is thirsty, given him drink.

- 1- Important point: logistical grace is guaranteed to every believer by the justice of God.
- 2- There is no sin or lifestyle which a believer may adopt which could cancel his supply line from God.
- 3- Free enterprise is the system which God has designed to provide that daily supply line to His royal family.
- 4- The supply line is often channeled through fellow humans acting under the motivation of the Holy Spirit.
- 5- If you discover your enemy hungry and thirsty and do not feed him but instead permit him to starve or thirst to death, then you have superimposed personal vindication over the justice of God.
- 6- Your enemy in this context is a believer. If you find him in a life threatening situation and you are in a position to supply him his necessary logistics and do not do so, then you are guilty of short-circuiting grace.
- 7- Consequently, God can provide for this person from another source, or he may allow the person to die and take him home under the sin unto death. That's His choice.
- 8- But either way, you have failed the test and now find the justice of God focused on you.
- 9- Only the justice of God has the right to impute human life to the soul and only the justice of God has the right to remove it.
- 10- When you opt to avenge yourself then punishment from God is directed toward you.
- 11- Deference to the justice of God therefore becomes a demonstration of FLOT Line efficiency under pressure:
 - 1- Deference indicates that all the problem-solving devices are functioning efficiently:
 - a. Rebound. No emotional implosion building up pressure leading to an explosion.
 - b. Filling of the Holy Spirit. Energizes the Divine Power System and access to its eight gates of function.

- c. Faith-Rest Drill. Dependence on the various rationales which keeps one's attention focused on Jesus Christ's control of history.
 - d. Grace Orientation. Evaluation of every situation from the standpoint of Genuine Humility.
 - e. Doctrinal Orientation. Evaluation of every situation from the standpoint of doctrinal analysis rather than human viewpoint.
 - f. Personal Love for God. Appreciation for the unlimited devotion and care our Father directs toward us.
 - g. Impersonal love for all mankind. Dealing with others based on your own integrity rather than unrealistic expectations.
 - h. Sharing the happiness of God. An inner resource which evaluates circumstances from the standpoint of their eternal rather than their temporal implications.
 - i. A personal sense of destiny. Understanding your place in the Plan of God and a confidence that it is eternally secure.
 - j. Occupation with Christ. An attitude that all things are being controlled by Him for your benefit and His glory.
- 2- Among these problem-solving devices the one which has top priority in dealing with those hostile to you is the seventh one: unconditional love for all mankind.
- 3- Application of the Royal Family Honor Code under pressure in all the categories which we have noted in Romans 12.
- 4- Execution of the Christian way of life by functioning at all eight gates of the Divine Power System which dovetails with the problem-solving devices:
- G-1. Filling of the Holy Spirit which is PSD #2.
 - G-2. Rebound and the Faith-Rest Drill which are PSDs #1 and #3.
 - G-3. Enforced and Genuine Humility which leads to teachability which is PSD #4: Grace Orientation to Life.
 - G-4. Grace Apparatus for Perception which results in PSD #5: Doctrinal Orientation to Reality.
 - G-5. Personal love for God which is PSD #6.
 - G-6. Unconditional love for all mankind which is PSD #7.

- G-7. Momentum Testing which demands the use of Gates 1 through 6 and all ten of the PSDs.
- G-8. Sharing the happiness of God. Begins at spiritual self-esteem and grows to become the prevailing mental attitude once Momentum Testing is passed. It is PSD #8.
- 5- A personal sense of destiny keeps one's eyes focused on his eternal future and its guarantees.
- 6- Occupation with Christ keeps one's eyes focused on His prototype example of this entire system.
- 12- When some believer is hostile toward you, all of these principles should begin to flow into the stream of consciousness of your soul.
- 13- The Holy Spirit will multiplex certain pertinent doctrines which, combined with this system of problem solving, will remind you that justice will be served if adjudication is left in the hands of the Lord.
- 14- Consequently, you realize that if your antagonist is hungry or thirsty and you have the power to assist him, then honor demands you do so.
- 15- This enables you to pass a test, a test which challenges you to become impatient with the timing of God's plan.
- 16- The perpetrator of a hostile act toward you is now vulnerable. You are tempted to change the venue of the trial back from the Supreme Court of Heaven to the courtroom of personal vengeance.
- 17- In so doing, righteous indignation and self-righteousness convince you that you are justified in carrying out God's punishment of this person.
- 18- When you do this you fail the test and lose a major battle in the Angelic Conflict.
- 19- However, when you continue to defer to the justice of God you demonstrate integrity by assisting in any way you can the one who has been hostile to you.
- 20- When this demonstration of Christian Integrity is fulfilled it permits divine justice to continue its prosecution--"for in doing this, you will pile up burning coals of fire on his head."
