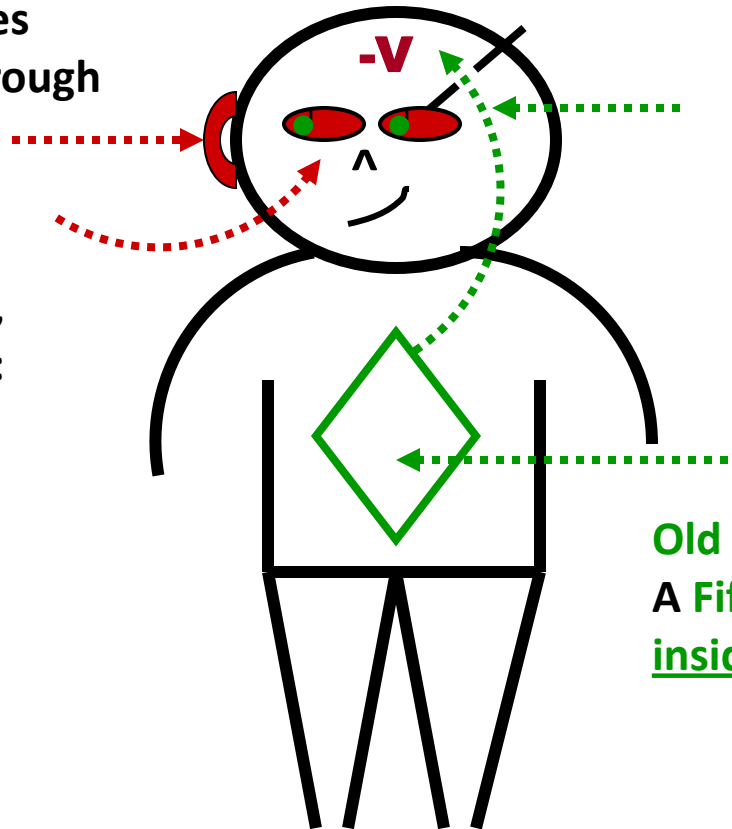


Intrinsic & Extrinsic Fifth Columns

The **Fifth Column** infiltrates from outside the body through **doctrines of demons**: Human viewpoint, human good, & evil from cosmic philosophies, e.g., Progressive ideology: multiculturalism, political correctness, & globalism.



Agent provocateurs from the lust pattern penetrate the soul giving the **sinful nature** control over thought, decision, & action.

Old Sin Nature:
A **Fifth Column** inside the body.

5. Doctrinal Orientation (Rom 12:2-3)
6. Personal Sense of Destiny (Rom 14:7-8)
7. Personal Love for God (Rom 8:28)
8. Unconditional Love for All Mankind (1 Cor 13:4-7)
9. Sharing the Happiness of God (Jn 15:11)
10. Occupation with Christ (Phil 1:20-21)

The Cognate Dative in 1 Peter 1:8

FORMAL: The noun & verb have the same root.
The noun **χαρά** (*chará*) and the verb **χαίρω** (*chaíró*).

CONCEPTUAL: The root words are different:
The noun **χαρά** (*chará*) and the verb **ἀγαλλιάω** (*agalliáō*).

The force of the cognate dative will be primarily to *emphasize the action of the verb agalliáō*.

HARMONY: Outer & Inner

ἐξωτερικὴ ἁρμονία

(*exōterikē harmonía*):

Outer harmony and
concord with others.

ἐσωτερικὴ ἁρμονία

(*esōterikē harmonía*):

Inner harmony of the soul.

1 Peter 1:8

Corrected & Expanded Translation

1 Peter 1:8 - ... and though you have never seen Him [οὐκ + ὁράω (*ouk + horáō*)], you continue loving Him [ἀγαπάω (*agapáō*)], with reference to Whom at the present time [ἄρτι (*árti*)] you continue not seeing Him [μή + ὁράω (*mē + horáō*)], yet you keep on believing [πιστεύω (*pisteúō*)] with sublime unalloyed happiness [ἀγαλλιάω + χαρά (*agalliáō*)] that is inexpressible [ἀνεκλόλη (*aneklálē*)] and full of resplendent glory, (EXT)

EPHESIANS 1:19

Power Nouns & Expanded Translation

The Power Nouns:

... and what is the surpassing greatness [δύναμις (*dúnamis*): omnipotence; intrinsic power]

of His power: [ἐνέργεια (*enérgeia*): active or operational power]

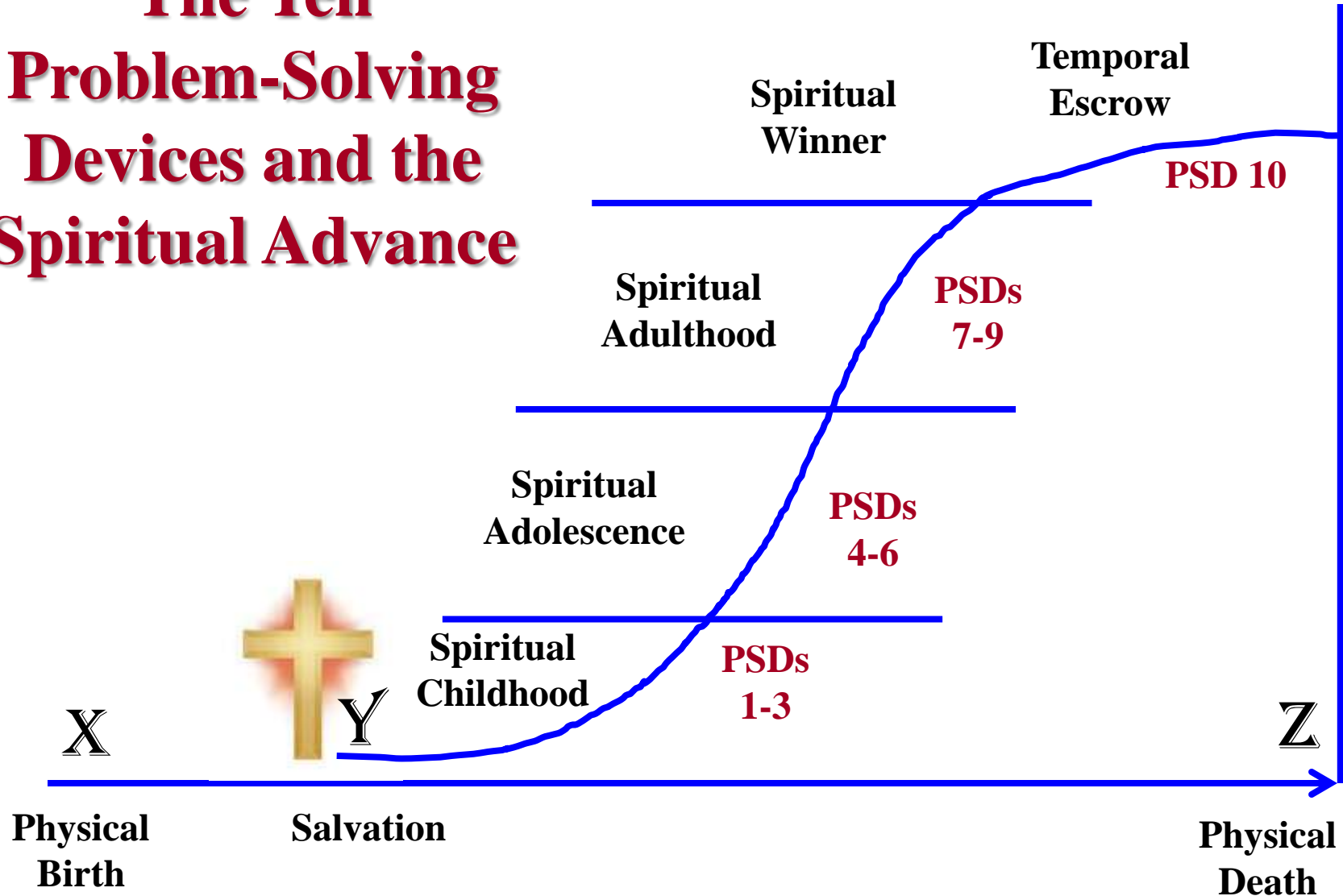
delegated to us who believe [πιστεύω (*pisteúō*)], in accordance with the ruling power: [κράτος (*krátos*): manifest power, i.e., expressed in Scripture]

of His inner power: [ἰσχύς (*ischús*): functional power, i.e., resident in the believer's soul].

Expanded Translation:

... and what is the surpassing greatness of His omnipotence (*dúnamis*) related to His plan upon us, the believing ones, according to the Holy Spirit's operational power (*enérgeia*) of the Word of God's intrinsic power (*krátos*) of the believer's endowed power (*ischús*).
