

The 5 Captains Recruit the Levites; The Coup D'État is Justified Since Athaliah Usurped the Throne: Traditionalists vs. Progressives: California Dreaming

- 2 Chronicles 23:2 And they [the five captains] went throughout Judah and gathered the Levites from all the cities of Judah, and the heads of the fathers' households of Israel, and they came to Jerusalem.
- v. 3 Then all the assembly made a covenant with the king in the house of the God. And Jehojada said to them, "Behold, the king's son shall reign, as the Lord has spoken concerning the sons of David.

Once the Cherethites and Levites were assembled at the Temple, Jehoiada reminded them of the divine justification for carrying out the coup d'état he was proposing. Not only did he present to them the legitimate heir to the throne but also associated the young lad's ascension with the Davidic Covenant:

- 2 Samuel 7:12 "When your days are complete and you lie down with your fathers, I will raise up your descendant after you, who will come forth from you, and I will establish his kingdom.
- 2 Samuel 7:16 And your house and your kingdom shall endure before Me forever; your throne shall be established forever."

Realizing that the line of David can be restored to the throne, the Cherethites and Levites were willing to join Jehoiada in a collaborative effort to anoint Joash as king of Judah.

One might ponder if this action was justified since it smacks of revolution. Well, no. What Athaliah did was revolution, in fact terrorism. She was not of the tribe of Judah but rather half Jewish, her father from a tribe unknown except that it could not have been either Judah or Benjamin. She was half Phoenician, her mother the pagan daughter of Ethbaal of Tyre.

Further, the Davidic Covenant clearly indicates that those who are to hold the throne of Judah are male offsprings of David's line. Not only was Athaliah unqualified to ascend the throne she accomplished her illegal objective by assassinating her grandchildren, the small sons of her son, Ahaziah. Were it not for the clandestine work of her step-daughter, Jehosheba, Athaliah would have accomplished Lucifer's mission of destroying the line of Christ.

The power in Judah lay ultimately with the throne. But Athaliah usurped the throne through bloodshed but had no qualifications for the office. Jehoiada was the spiritual leader of the nation and had knowledge that the legitimate heir of Ahaziah was sequestered in his quarters inside the Temple complex. He also knew that if Joash's presence ever became known to Athaliah, she would have him murdered, too. Thus, the only legitimate authority functioning in Judah was Jehoiada, the high priest.

As high priest, he could not properly lead the people in the worship of **YHWH** *Elohim* when Athaliah had elevated the worship of Baal as the preeminent religion in nation.

Although the human soul possesses free will it must be recognized that when a large number of people accumulate in the same geographic location and establish a nation, free people are free to regulate the power of the government they form.



Presently, the United States is in a tug of war between two worldviews: (1) Traditionalism and (2) Progressivism. It is helpful to review these two worldviews. We do so from:

There are a number of words used to indicate the nature and direction of social, political, and economic change. The status quo is the current historical situation in a particular community, state, or nation. (Traditionalists) are people who want to maintain the status quo. **Progressives** are people who advocate a new social, political, or economic order that provides for more personal and group freedom, and a greater equalization of opportunity, wealth, and power. Reactionaries are people who want to return to an older order characterized by some traditional authoritarian rule.

If change is partial and occurs through the channels of power considered legitimate in the status quo, it is called reform. Reform adds to the current arrangements or modifies them but it does not attempt to create a new order.

Radical change can take place over a period of time, or it can happen suddenly. When radical change takes place suddenly and power relationships change practically overnight, such change is called revolutionary.

> In our country, Traditionalists are those whose status quo is based on the original intent of the Constitution, the principle of community standards, biblical morality, and patriotism. Progressives are those who press for change accomplished by loose, fanciful readings of the Constitution, the application of the Bill of Rights to the States instead of the federal government, humanistic amorality, and globalism.

> Traditionalists insist that freedom carries with it the obligations of personal responsibility and personal restraint while Progressives view freedom as a license that imposes no responsibility for one's decisions and places no restraints on one's actions.

> This has led to cultural warfare with both sides now possessing approximately an equal number of troops. But pendulums swing both ways and the citizens of California have about had as much Progressivism as they can stand, at least out of their present governor, Gray Davis. This man has so fouled the works citizens are signing a petition to remove him from office. If they are successful then reform can occur by at least a slight pendulum reversal toward Traditionalist principles.

The result of this saga remains to be seen but it is not without its shenanigans and one concerned Californian has written to me on the subject. Out of respect for his privacy his name will be withheld but I am sure his query is typical of many believers in the Golden State:

I'd like to ask you a question about a recent class in which you spoke of enduring the tough times, specifically the decisions of our leaders and not taking measures into our own hands. i.e., assassination, revolting, murder, etc. In effect you said, we are to vote and endure.

Well, I reside in Los Angeles, California. You may be aware of the past and current economic crisis here, as well as the massive, liberal influence, California is essentially "in the tank". We have been enduring this crisis for some time even before energy taxes were raised back in 2000 and more recently culminating in the ridiculous tripling of vehicle license tax authorized personally by Gray Davis (which was almost astronomical to begin with). - 1 Peter 2:13 Submit yourselves for the Lord's sake to every human institution, whether to a king as the one in authority,
- v. 14 or to governors as sent by him for the punishment of evildoers and the praise of those who do right.
- v. 15 For such is the will of God that by doing right you may silence the ignorance of foolish men.
- v. 16 Act as free men, and do not use your freedom as a covering for evil, but use it as bondslaves to God.
- v. 17 Honor all men; love the brotherhood; fear God; honor the king.
