



Sex Ed's Premise Insults Children & Appalls Parents; Lust Patterns Should Not Be Encouraged; Progressive's Academic Tyranny Neutralizes Christian Parents

8. The Progressives' rhetorical veil is the assertion that children are going to engage in sexual behaviors anyway and only by showing them how to do this safely can pregnancy and sexually transmitted diseases be prevented.
9. The big emphasis in psycho-education today is to build self-esteem. How contradictory to tell a child that his "self-esteem" provides him with no "self-control" and therefore he is destined to engage in behaviors that will destroy his soul.
10. The rhetorical veil advances while it conceals a satanic hidden agenda: the destruction of the divine institutions of marriage and family in the coming generations.
11. Several media have taken up the cause and present the graduates of these courses with realistic though fictional portrayals of illicit sexual encounters — movies, cable television, videos, and DVDs.
12. The madness of this entire concept is that adults who call themselves the pedagogues of our next generation have stooped so low as to turn the public schoolroom into a training center for illicit sex.
13. Forgotten, ignored, or never even known is that the trends of the sinful nature include sexual lust. Once this lust pattern is activated it must be restrained or it will become an obsession to the person who is engulfed by it.
14. This problem is addressed by Paul in Romans 1:18-32 where he demonstrates that when a person engages in sexual relationships outside of marriage he begins a frantic search for happiness.
15. A person who is frantic is mentally deranged and emotionally out of control. His or her behavior is marked by disordered and anxiety-driven activity.
16. In Romans 1 we find the unbeliever who, after having rejected God, moves into a downward spiral of an increasingly degenerate lifestyle.
17. Those who reject God must ultimately find guidance from their own rationales developed from whatever their norms and standards happen to be.
18. If children have restraints removed by authority figures such as public school teachers who instruct them in the details of how to assuage their sexual desires then the end result is the self-fulfillment of prophecy.
19. The public school monopoly insists that children will engage in premarital sex and that pregnancies and sexually transmitted diseases will result.
20. They claim the way to stop this is to teach children to have sex safely. Tacit approval of this behavior without placing it in its proper environment of marriage to a right opposite number invites the very problems they claim they wish to prevent.



21. It is without question that the adults who have for the last 20 years been involved in the promotion and instruction of public-school sex-education classes have done more harm to this republic than the Islamic terrorists can ever hope to accomplish.

If any adult chose to gather a group of children into his own home in order to instruct them from a standard sex-education curriculum guide, once discovered the children's parents would be outraged, they would lift a hue and cry for his arrest, and he would be tried as a sexual pervert, his case reported daily on cable news, probably by Rita Cosby and Aphrodite Jones!
23. The disaster that underlies the national apathy about this subject is that the children's parents allow the very same thing to go on daily at the school and they have nothing to say about it.
24. And if they did they would be labeled "problem parents" and the child would suffer even further since his parents would be considered "out of the mainstream."
25. The problem with all this is that when pastors and parents seek to take issue with this insanity we come off as negative and the impression given is that we consider all sex to be wrong and sinful.
26. This is the unfortunate position that decent God-fearing believers are forced to assume. The truth is that sex is the invention of God. Married couples are commanded to have sexual relations with each other. The expansion of the body of Christ is dependent upon it.
