

15. Over time, moral confusion polarizes two worldviews, establishment and cosmic, the latter causing large numbers of citizens to be tragically lost between them.
16. This great divide exists to the pleasure of the Dark Side's strategy to create conflict between traditional Western culture and that inspired by Marxism.
17. The underlying attitudes of these worldviews are contradictory and mutually exclusive, therefore both cannot be held by the same person at the same time.
18. The Marxist worldview may be summarized as follows:
 - (1) There is a global conspiracy, but it is orchestrated by Lucifer and his demon army.
 - (2) His strategy is global government by means of compartmentalizing humans.
 - (3) Compartments are organized in the form of special interest groups and administered by those who are in the throes of crusader arrogance.
 - (4) Crusader arrogance is subcategory 4 in the Cosmic System of self-righteousness. It is defined as a strong or impulsive desire to superimpose one's opinion and principles on others without their consent. The person involved in crusader arrogance believes he is so right and his cause so just that he is justified in using any means to gain his objective, including violence, destruction of property, and causing others to lose their jobs.
 - (5) Recruits are gathered by the presentation of the lie. Example: "Hands up; don't shoot."
 - (6) Through duplicity and deceit, Lucifer promotes his hidden agenda by means of rhetorical veils which conceal while advancing his cause. Example: Al Sharpton's accusation that changes must be made among the police forces of America because they are disproportionately targeting black people. Statistics overwhelmingly indicate otherwise.

- (7) “Change” is the desired objective of the rhetorical veil and its hidden agenda of disempowering establishment while empowering human good and evil.
- (8) The only defense against his insidious assault is to garrison the soul with divine truth which identifies the lie and protects the believer from being neutralized in the Angelic Conflict.
- (9) Satan’s strategy and tactics can be discerned from his Articles of War issued to God in eternity past and recorded by Isaiah in:

Isaiah 14:12 - “How you have fallen from heaven, O star of the morning, son of the dawn [הֵלֵל בֶּן־שָׁחַר] (*Helel ben-Shachar*); translated “Lucifer” (KJV)¹! You have been cut down to the earth, you, who have weakened the nations!

v. 13 - “But you said in your heart, ‘I will ascend [Qal imperfect of עָלָה (*alah*): incomplete action of moving upward] to (the third) heaven; I will raise [Hiphil imperfect of רָם (*rum*): to be exalted; incomplete action] my throne above the stars [the angelic creation] of God [עֲלִיּוֹן (*Elyon*): In Canaanite mythology the stars of El were astral deities under the authority of the high god El], and I will sit [Qal imperfect of יָשָׁב (*yashav*): incomplete action of sitting] on the mount of assembly in the recesses of the north.

v. 14 - ‘I will climb up [Qal imperfect of עָלָה (*alah*): incomplete action of moving upward] to the tops of the clouds; I will make [Hithpael imperfect of דָּמָה (*damah*): intensive incomplete action of making oneself like someone else] myself like the Most High.” (EXT)

¹ In Isa. 14:12 of the King James Version, the proper noun, Lucifer, is the Latin word for “light-bearer,” and is used to translate the Hebrew word הֵלֵל (*Helel*), which means “radiant star.” The New American Standard Bible translates *Helel* “Star of the Morning.” The Hebrew text continues with the phrase בֶּן־שָׁחַר (*ben-Shachar*), translated “son of the dawn” in all the major English versions. Star of the Morning, Son of the Dawn refers to the superior officer of the Dark Side, the cherub-ranked fallen angel known by the monikers, Satan or devil, but whose real name is *Helel ben-Shachar*. Employing the Latin noun, Lucifer, conveniently summarizes all of these translations.

- (10) Lucifer is identified by our Lord as the greatest deceiver in history in John 8:44, "He is a liar, and the father of lies."
- (11) Absence of biblical truth in the soul means that believers as well as unbelievers will consistently lie.
- (12) Believers without doctrine are easy targets since Lucifer works through human beings. Having rejected, avoided, or spurned Bible doctrine they will automatically lie.

1 John 1:6 - If we say that we have fellowship with Him and yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth. (NASB)

2 Thessalonians 2:11 - For this reason God will send upon them a deluding influence so that they will believe what is false,

2 Thessalonians 2:12 - in order that they all may be judged who did not believe the truth, but took pleasure in wickedness. (NASB)
