Deaths: Spiritual and Physical in the Old Testament

Isaiah 53:9 - His grave was assigned with wicked men, yet He was with a rich man in His <u>deaths</u> [קָת (maweth): noun], because He had done no violence, nor was there any deceit in His mouth.

Genesis 2:17 - "But from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for the day that you eat from it you will surely die."

The doubling of the Hebrew verb מרת *muth*:

מות הַמוּת (moth: the Qal infinitive absolute: "will surely"

and tamuth: the Qal imperfect: "die").
