Lesson 4:

Marriage Importance: It Affects Parenting

There are two responsibilities, yea, four inevitable results of either a positive or negative marriage experience brought to the family.

The confusion that comes as a result of these either/or situations will determine which way the Family goes. Either Positive or Negative. Of course, this is seldom a black and white situation that prevails even though there is always the evidence these behaviors (Good and Bad) are present to some degrees in each marriage. Each marriage, because of flawed human beings, has some evidence of both positive and negative results. The family will reflect this degree of failure and success. Parents are the leaders. As goes the leaders, so goes the family.

1. The Marriage either brings Love (worthy), Importance (value), and Accepting (belonging) to all members of the Family or a marriage will create an atmosphere of Rejection, being Unloved, and Inadequacy to all members of the Family.

Each Member can then choose to accept or reject either the rejection or acceptance, etc.

2. Either the marriage will demonstrate the appropriate use of authority (responsibility) or the misuse of authority (abuse).

And they shared the word of the Lord with him and with all who lived in his household. Even at that hour of the night, the jailer cared for them and washed their wounds. Then he and everyone in his household were immediately baptized. (Acts 16:31–32)
