The United Kingdom. From Saul to Rehoboam. 1020–926 B.C.

The Northern Kingdom of Israel. From Jeroboam I to Hoshea. 926–721 B.C. Fifth cycle administered by Assyria under Sargon II.

The Southern Kingdom of Judah. From Rehoboam to Zedekiah. 926–586 B.C. Fifth cycle administered by Chaldea under Nebuchadnezzar II.

The Restored Kingdom of Judah. From Zerubbabel to final Diaspora. 536 B.C.–A.D. 70. Fifth Cycle administered by SPQR under Vespasian and Titus.
