Genesis 2:16 - The Lord God [בְּלֹהִים] (YHWH 'Elohim): Jesus Christ] commanded the man, saying, "From any tree of the garden you may freely [infinitive absolute of בְלֵל ('achal): eating] eat;

v. 17 - "but from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for the day that you eat from it you will surely [אוֹם (moth): the Qal infinitive absolute: dying spiritually] die [אוֹם (tamuth): the Qal imperfect: physically]."

<u>Genesis 3:3</u> - "But from the fruit of the tree which is in the middle of the garden, <u>God</u> [אֱלֹהָים (*'Elohim*)] said, "You shall not eat from it, neither shall you <u>touch it</u>, lest you die."

<u>Genesis 3:4</u> - The Satan possessed serpent said to the woman, "You will <u>not dying die</u> [אַל (lo') בוּרת (muth)]."
