LAW OF VOLITIONAL RESPONSIBILITY: Principles

1. A deliberate wrong action is the effect caused by wrong thoughts, wrong motivations, and wrong decisions.

2. An impulsive wrong action is the effect caused by submission to the lust pattern in search of self-gratification.

3. Deliberate wrong actions at least are thought out and, although erroneous, they do involve thoughts, motives, and decisions.

4. Impulsive wrong actions are spontaneous and thus ignore thoughts, motives, and decisions.

5. Self-indulgence is an unrestrained response to the seductive allurements offered by *Cosmos Diabolicus* and is characterized by an unbridled urge to gratify the lust patterns of the sin nature.
