

LAW OF VOLITIONAL RESPONSIBILITY: Principles

- 1. A deliberate wrong action is the effect caused by wrong thoughts, wrong motivations, and wrong decisions.**
- 2. An impulsive wrong action is the effect caused by submission to the lust pattern in search of self-gratification.**
- 3. Deliberate wrong actions at least are thought out and, although erroneous, they do involve thoughts, motives, and decisions.**
- 4. Impulsive wrong actions are spontaneous and thus ignore thoughts, motives, and decisions.**
- 5. Self-indulgence is an unrestrained response to the seductive allurements offered by *Cosmos Diabolicus* and is characterized by an unbridled urge to gratify the lust patterns of the sin nature.**
