

Sequence & Arrangement of the Tripartite Hebrew Canon

The Torah: תּוֹרָה \ *Torah* \ or the Pentateuch: Πεντάτευχος \ *Pentateuchos* \ (five books): Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, & Deuteronomy.

The Prophets: נְבִיאִים \ *Wevi'im* \ (eight books in two categories):

1. The Former Prophets (four books): Joshua, Judges, Samuel*, & Kings*.
2. The Latter Prophets (four books in two subcategories):
 - (1) The Major Prophets (three books): Isaiah, Jeremiah, & Ezekiel.
 - (2) The Minor Prophets or The Twelve (one book): Hosea, Joel, Amos, Obadiah, Jonah, Micah, Nahum, Habakkuk, Zephaniah, Haggai, Zechariah, & Malachi.

The Writings: כְּתוּבִים \ *Kethuvim* \ (eleven books in three categories):

1. Poetic (three books): Psalms, Proverbs, & Job.
2. The Megilloth or Five Rolls (five books): Song of Solomon, Ruth, Lamentations, Ecclesiastes, & Esther.
3. Historical (three books): Daniel, Ezra-Nehemiah*, & Chronicles*.

* Divided into two books in Christian Bibles.
