

- 18- Therefore, in addition to the principle of +R, there is the consideration of the privacy of the priesthood. If every believer is not given privacy then his advance is slowed and even halted.
- 19- God loves every believer as much as He does another. Thus our attitude toward other members of the royal family must never insult the integrity of God.
- 20- If you "esteem others more highly than yourself" then there can be no room for gossip, maligning, anger, revenge, inordinate competition or any form of spiritual one-upsmanship.
- 21- Consequently the protocol for dealing with members of the royal family mandates that you show deference to other believers as a matter of honor.
- 22- Next follows a series of terse mandates requiring applications which have both indirect and direct impact on one's fellow believers.

**Honor Code Principle #5:** Failure to persevere in the inculcation of doctrine has a negative impact on one's application of the honor code. Through the filling of the Holy Spirit, consistent service to our Lord is maintained. Romans 12:

v 11 = With regard to your due diligence, do not be negligent; with reference to the Holy Spirit be zealous when serving the Lord.

- 1- The word I have translated "due diligence" is the locative of sphere from the noun **SPOUDn'** which means "to have diligence in matters of religion."  
*(SPIRITUAL SIGNIFICANCE)*
- 2- "Due diligence" is a legal term and is defined by the Oxford English Dictionary as "the attention and care due from a person in a given situation, specifically that incumbent upon the parties to a contract."
- 3- When we become members of the royal family, the first document file of our portfolio includes the Equal Privilege of Election.
- 4- Our election by God gives us the privilege of joining the Pivot of our generation's client nation.
