

### Reversionism Review

Reversionism is a term developed from the English word “revert” which is borrowed from the Latin revertere meaning “to return to a former condition,” or “to turn back.”

The believer who has made some advance in his spiritual growth will, in reversionism, “forget” every doctrine he has learned. Rejection of one system of thinking will always result in accepting the principles of another system of thinking.

There are really only two systems of thinking in the world, (1) the curriculum of the Divine Academy of Grace Didactics, and (2) the Satanic Academy of Cosmic Didactics.

The Grace Academy is founded on truth while the Cosmic Academy is founded on the lie. When a person believes in Jesus Christ for salvation he instantly withdraws from the Cosmic Academy and enrolls in the Grace Academy.
