How to Deal with a Recovering Reversionist

Colossians 3:13 - bearing with one another and forgiving each other, whoever has a complaint against anyone; just as the Lord forgave you, so also should you.

Colossians 3:14 - And beyond all these things put on virtue love, which is the perfect bond of unity.

Colossians 3:15 - And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts [kardia: streams of consciousness], to which indeed you were called in one body [universal church]; and be thankful.

Colossians 3:16 - Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you.

The principle of all this is that when you put on Christ—*enduo*—your soul is transformed culminating in the fact that your life reflects to the world the indwelling Shekinah Glory. And what you put on in order to be transformed is the Mind of Christ—the immutable Word of God.

Every principle of doctrine that you learn results in the acquisition of divine thought in the stream of consciousness. These are the wheel-tracks of righteousness.

Just as the wheel-tracks of wickedness are molded by a tediously slow process, so are the wheel-tracks of righteousness. This principle is brought out by the instrumental of means from the noun: *anakainosis* - "renewal"; "renovation"
