Law #2: <u>The responsibility of the wife</u>:

Ephesians 5:22 - Wives, submit yourselves to the authority of your own husbands, as to the Lord,

v 23 - because the husband is the head [ruler] of the wife, just as Christ also is the head [ruler] of the church, He Himself is the Savior of the body.

v 24 - But as the church is subordinate to Christ, so also wives are under the authority of their husbands in all things.

- 1) Just as the husband must fulfill the First Law of the Christian Marriage by means of the tandem problemsolving devices, so also must the wife fulfill the Second Law in the this same fashion.
- 2) Her recognition and obedience to her husband's authority is dependent upon this principle.
- 3) <u>Respect</u> is the highest form of virtue-love the woman can have for the man.

Oxford English Dictionary, s.v. "respect":

To give heed, attention, or consideration to; 2. to show partiality or favor;
to show deferential regard or esteem towards a person; 4. to regard with deference, esteem, or honor; 5. to treat with consideration; 6. to refrain from interfering with.

Liddell, Henry & Robert Scott. *A Greek-English Lexicon,* s.v. φοβέω:

Deference motivated by fear with a touch of awe.

Vine, W. E. An Expository Dictionary of Biblical Words, s.v. φοβέω:

- Reverential fear on the part of the wife for the husband; 2. motivated by reverential fear of God as a controlling motive of the life in matters spiritual and moral; 3. a wholesome dread of displeasing God; 4. an influence on disposition and attitude of one whose circumstances are guided by trust in God.
 - 4) Since the woman is not mandated to love the man then there is nothing greater than when she does so from her own free will.
 - 5) Her love is expressed responsively through respect which is admiration and approbation combined with deference and partiality.
 - 6) Her husband's consecration of her motivates her to respond with esteem for him, an expression of the high value she holds in her soul for her husband.
 - 7) Admiration and approbation is how she expresses her love. Deference and partiality is the manner by which she expresses her obedience.
 - The Greek verb ὑποτάσσω means to subject oneself to the authority of someone. The husband, therefore, is the leader, the woman is a responder.
 - 9) The wife's motivation to respond comes from personal love for God and her capacity to respond comes from unconditional love for mankind.
 - 10) The wife's willing subordination to the authority of her husband is the result of respect, which is her response to his enduring devotion.
 - 11) Her willing submission means her response originates from the freedom of her own soul.
 - 12) Therefore, a wife's willing subordination to her husband is not demeaning but instead demands the highest form of integrity on her part.
