

## The Inscrutable Question: Review of Infralapsarianism; Satanic Agenda to Destroy the Line of Christ, Gen 6:1-2

- 13) At the moment the prophecy was announced it became Lucifer's major objective to prevent it from ever occurring. This precipitated an ongoing agenda of Satan by which he sought to destroy the line of Christ and eventually the entire human gene pool.
- 14) The first assault on the line of Christ was the murder of a believer, Abel, by his unbelieving brother, Cain in Genesis 4:8. However, Adam's third son, Seth took Abel's place in the line of Christ.
- 15) At the time murdering Abel might have seemed a good idea since he was the only believing offspring of Adam and Ishah. But as time passed a population explosion occurred over the earth and many daughters were born into the human race. The fact they outnumbered the men and became the objects of lustful attraction to the fallen angels prompted Lucifer to initiate the most devastating assault ever on the line of Christ.

**Genesis 6:1** - Now it came about, when men began to multiply on the face of the land, and daughters were born to them,

**v. 2** - that the sons of God saw that the daughters of men were beautiful; and they took for themselves, whomever they wanted.

- 16) The phrase "sons of God" is a Hebrew idiom that always refers to angels, never men. Do not confuse this Hebrew term with similar terms in the Greek New Testament where "Son of God" refers to Jesus Christ and "sons of God" refers to believers.
- 17) In Genesis 6:2 we find **בְּנֵי הָאֱלֹהִים** / **bene ha Elohim** /, translated "sons of God" and it refers to angels, all of whom were created by the second Person of the Trinity, Jesus Christ. The ones who are referred to in context are fallen angels who have just violated a major rule of conduct governing the behavior of angels in the Invisible War.
- 18) This reveals to us some information about the characteristics of angels and mankind prior to the flood. First the angels were visible to the human race, the "sons of God" being extremely attractive to the women.
