



## The Inscrutable Question: Satanic Academy's School of Arrogance: Human Good & the Rise & Fall of the SUV; Satanic Academy's School of Antagonism

6- In the School of Arrogance the Satanic Academy teaches several courses in Satanology that have to do with one's relationship toward self and others:

- 1) **Legalism:** This involves emphasis on human achievement. It ignores the requirement of the filling of the Holy Spirit and emphasizes making the world a better place.

This includes observance of taboos that are designed by Satan to help restrain the activities of the sinful nature while promoting his global agenda of world peace and brotherhood. The process includes the notion of spirituality by works by which one demonstrates his advance in the cosmic system.

- 2) **Morality:** This becomes a means of salvation for the unbeliever and a substitute for the Christian way of life for the believer. It is really moral arrogance since all efforts are motivated by human viewpoint and produce human good. The motivation is wrong because it seeks to accomplish divine ends by human means and aggrandizes self rather than God.

- 3) **Crusades:** This is an advanced course in the application of arrogance that seeks to whitewash the devil's world by means of human energy. A crusade can emphasize any number of causes, for example, preservation of the environment. The cadet is taught several doctrines of demons: the earth is being destroyed by humans who burn garbage, drive SUVs, heat their homes, and run businesses. Based on these lies they are then taught a rhetorical veil: Global Warming. The world is not warming at all but the cadets are taught that it is. This is a rhetorical veil designed to conceal while it advances a hidden agenda. The hidden agenda is never taught to the cadets since the rhetorical veil is designed to conceal it from the "useful idiots." The rhetorical veil of Global Warming plays on the emotion of fear—"We're all going to die"—and self-righteous arrogance—"I must do something to stop it."

The hidden agenda is the development of international laws, treaties, rules, and regulations that micromanage human activities toward the objective of establishing a global government. By controlling the very raw materials and natural resources by which national economies function means that satanically motivated people, manipulated by doctrines of demons, would eventually, in theory, control or manipulate all world governments. The nation hit hardest in this effort is the United States and as a client nation is the obvious primary target for this assault. In the Church Age, client nations present the only restraint to Lucifer's plan for global domination. (2 Thessalonians 2:1-12)

There are many crusades but what characterizes any person involved in one is the belief that his cause is so right and just that he may with impunity use any means to gain his objective. This allows him and his fellow crusaders to justify vigilante actions that include violence, harassment, and destruction of private property or to lobby for laws that weaken the economy, cause loss of jobs, and drive people from their own property or limit what they can do with their own property.

The irony of crusades is that when the proponents of a cause find their personal interests affected they blame the problem on someone else, usually capitalism, a political party, or Christians. Another approach is to offer crocodile tears as a rhetorical veil to conceal silent approval of another victory for the crusade. The *St. Louis Post-Dispatch* has been editorializing for months about how SUVs should be outlawed or heavily taxed. Yet the major products assembled by the local Ford plant are SUVs. Rather than expressing joy and approval for Ford's decision to close the Hazelwood Plant, a recent *Post-Dispatch* editorial expressed regret at the loss of jobs but suggested yet another human good solution to the problem:

**Black Friday.** To the uninitiated, producing the nation's best-selling sport utility vehicle might seem like the best possible job security. But as 2,600 workers at Ford Motor Co.'s Hazelwood Plant discovered Friday, there are some painful realities from which even success can't insulate them.

One year ago, boosted by the Explorer's profitability, Ford reported a \$6.67 billion profit. This week, after a year of vehicle recalls and rollover suits, the company announced plans to cut 35,000 jobs worldwide and close five plants. Among them is the Hazelwood facility which makes the popular Ford Explorer and Mercury Mountaineer.

State and local officials have begun lobbying Ford to keep the facility open. But there are limits to what government can do. Over the past 10 years, Missouri provided Ford with \$24 million in job training money, but that did not save the plant.

Prudence dictates that state and federal governments immediately begin the job of retraining auto industry workers. In the long run, St. Louis' future may lie more with bio-technology and a diversified economy than heavy industry. But that's scant comfort for thousands of well-paid Ford workers and the communities in which they live.

- 4) **Christian Service:** This course teaches that works are required to enter into heaven, to impress or please God, or to promote oneself to others and thus acquire the approval of one's fellow man. If your fellow man is impressed then God must be.
- 2- In the School of Antagonism the Satanic Academy teaches several courses in Satanology that have to do with one's relationship toward the plan of God:
- 1) **Antagonism toward God:** This is where the unbeliever gives mental assent to demon influence and demon possession and where the reversionistic believer gives mental assent to demon influence. This results in hostility toward God, Jesus Christ, the Bible, churches, Christians, and divine viewpoint.
  - 2) **Anti-establishment:** Here the antagonism is directed toward all four divine institutions. Volition is restricted by laws that micromanage the lives of all who disagree with the approved crusades. Marriage is demeaned by expanding its boundaries to include homosexual couples or ignored by approval of adulterous relationships. The traditional family is belittled by comparing it sarcastically to Ward and June Clever or degraded to include relationships beyond husbands, wives, and children. Nationalism is deemphasized by global entanglements or undermined by the promotion of multiculturalism and diversity.

In each case the authority structure of each establishment category is discredited as intolerant and replaced with politically correct substitutes.

- 3) **Cosmic panaceas:** This course develops human viewpoint philosophies that promote human good and evil designed to bring about social unanimity and harmony. The satanic program encourages equality without merit, freedom without responsibility, and respect without virtue. Those with divine viewpoint never have a desire to be treated equally except before the law. Those with divine viewpoint do have a desire to be treated fairly. When treated fairly a person is recognized and rewarded for his merits, his sense of responsibility, and his virtues. To be considered as equal to those without merit, a sense of responsibility, or virtue is unjust and thus unfair.
